



## Grave Relief of Claudius

### Description

The horizontal relief crowned by a pediment with a rosette shows the deceased, a male dressed in a Greek tunic and long cloak. He reclines on a dining couch beside a three-legged table with cakes; he may be holding a cup. The scene belongs to the funeral

banquet, a popular type among the Antioch reliefs (Kondoleon, 2000).)
