Description

Daisho set with 1917.69. Blade bears horimono of bonji (outside) and suken (inside). Fittings from the early 19th century, match those of the katana 1917.69.1. Grip of ray skin wrapped in braided silk cord with menuki in copper alloy and gold. Tsuba of chiseled inlaid iron. All metal fittings with samurai themes.
