etched iron, brass inlay, wood

### **Description**

Iron. Flat, leaf-shaped double edge blade with tall conical socket. Both faces of blade etched with thuluth script overall. Socket inlaid

with thick, crude strips of brass wire in undulating & straight axial lines. Traces of effaced molding at base of socket & other older decoration suggest head decorated at later date during working life. Circular-section wooden shaft, perhaps restored; hole at the base of the shaft evidently for an old display mounting.
