Description

hilt of Indo-Muslim, Hyderabad (Deccan) type. Single-edge down curving watered steel blade. Floral & vine gold "koft-gari" on rear edge of blade, both faces of forte, and forward edge of ricasso. Talwar-style hilt with short crossguards having slightly spherical terminals. Langets terminating in arrow-shaped points, grip swollen at mid-length & shallow discoid pommel with domed insert topped by button with attached openwork swivel-ring. Hilt covered in dense floral gold "koft-gari."
