black-painted steel with iron, brass and leather fragments

Description
Almond-shaped, one-piece skull with small rearwardly-angled finial at apex. Longitudinal, full length medial ridge to integral brim, which narrows at anterior and posterior. 4 holes for a lost plume holder at rear of skull. Carrying hole in brim at front.
