### **Description**

Short cusped sleeves, with overlapped V-neck and remains of a leather collar. Multiple types of mail are present. The chest has all riveted links, internal dia. c. 7mm, apparently with rectangular rivetholes; these are very flat, worn, and patinated, and might be reused medieval European mail. The mail of the sleeves is similar. The back alternates between riveted and solid links; the front may be of the same mail. Lighter links at edge of sleeves. Round rivets, slightly proud. A number of iron attachments are riveted to mail,
