Description

Iron or steel. Long, solid haft of octagonal section on lower half, ending in rounded butt with "C"-shaped suspension ring. Haft is cylindrical above, terminating in large, heavy head of slightly flattened spherical shape. with turned ferrule below & carved, conical fitting above with short quadrangular spike. Sides of head are fitted with 7 faceted low hexagonal bossets; there is extensive copper brazing on the head.
