Title: Composite Stechzeug (armor for the "German Joust")

Date: about 1480–1540

Primary Maker: Valentin Siebenbürger

Medium: steel, brass, leather



Title: Infantry Breastplate "in the German style"

Date: about 1480

Primary Maker: Master "IA"

Medium: steel with modern leather



Title: Helmet in the form of a Sea Conch Shell

Date: 1618

Primary Maker: Nagasone Tojiro Mitsumasa

Medium: iron with traces of lacquer, textiles



Title: Right Gauntlet for Prince (later King) Philip of Spain (1527-1598)

Date: 1549–1550

Primary Maker: Desiderius Helmschmid

Medium: Steel, brass, and leather with gilding



Title: Corinthian Helmet

Date: 550–450 BCE

Primary Maker: Greek

Medium: bronze



Title: Wheel-Lock Carbine for the Personal Guard (Trabanten) of Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau, Prince-Archbishop of Salzburg (r. 1587-1611)

Date: about 1590

Primary Maker: German

Medium: steel, brass, bone, iron, and wood.



Title: "Gothic" Hunting Sword

Date: about 1490–1500

Primary Maker: Hans Sumersperger

Medium: steel and brass with dark and light horn



Title: Bow Case Cover

Date: 1600s

Primary Maker: Ottoman

Medium: iron, gold



Title: Armor for Field and Tilt, of Count Franz von Teuffenbach (1516-1578)

Date: 1554

Primary Maker: Stefan Rormoser

Medium: steel, brass, lampblack, restored leather



Title: Three-Quarter Field Armor, possibly for Henry Herbert, second Earl of Pembroke

Date: 1560–1570

Primary Maker: Northern Italian

Medium: steel (once blued) with gilding, brass, modern leather



Title: Comb Morion for the Guard of Christian I or II, Electors of Saxony

Date: about 1585–1595

Primary Maker: Master "MR"

Medium: blackened steel with etched and gilded decoration, brass, textile, leather



Title: Ngulu (ceremonial sword)

Date: early 1900s

Primary Maker: Congo Region, Central African

Medium: engraved iron, wood, brass, copper, leather



Title: Musele ("bird-headed" ceremonial knife)

Date: late 1800s or early 1900s

Primary Maker: Congo Region, Central African

Medium: iron, brass, copper wire



Title: Helmet for a Gladiator

Date: about 100 CE

Primary Maker: Roman

Medium: bronze



Title: Prototype Experimental Helmet Model 2

Date: 1917

Primary Maker: Worcester Pressed Steel

Medium: steel



Title: Field Armor from a Garniture

Date: about 1595

Primary Maker: Pompeo della Cesa

Medium: steel, brass, gold, silver, leather, fabric



Title: Smallsword

Date: about 1790

Primary Maker: Matthew Boulton

Medium: steel, faceted, burnished, blued and gilded, iron, and stoneware (Jasperware)



Title: Katar (punch dagger)

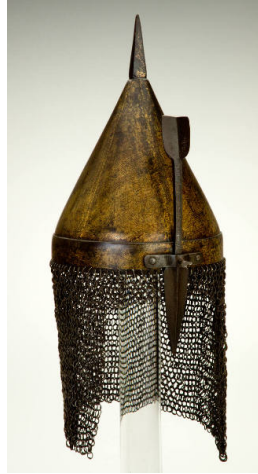
Date: 1700s

Primary Maker: Rajasthani

Medium: wootz (crucible steel), gold, iron



Title: Halberd for an officer of the Trained Band
Date: 1678
Medium: steel, wood (probably maple)



Title: Helmet
Date: 1800s
Medium: russeted iron with gilding
